



Registration Information for Summer of 2021

Eligibility:

First priority is given to Nelson Farm HOA Members, second is swimmers that have been on Nelson Farm Team the previous summer, third priority will be given to all others that meet the age and swimming eligibility. All swimmers need to be 18 years old or under as of May 15th of this year. Swimmers need to be able to swim the length of the 25 yards in at least freestyle or backstroke.

Swim Team members that join that are not part of the Nelson Farm HOA, may only use the pool during swim team practice or additional team activities.

Fee:

Cash or Check Fee: \$180.00 per child

Team Swim Caps can be purchased for an extra \$10.00/each for those that need a new one or would like one.

Practice:

Monday – Fridays: Tuesday, June 1, 2021 – Friday, July 16, 2021 or as we are allowed by the Nelson Farm HOA Board, State of Colorado and/or Larimer County. Summer state is tentatively scheduled for July 23 and 24, 2021.

Ages 11 and up will practice at 6:45 am – 8:00 am

Under 10 will practice at 8:05 am – 9:05 am

Coach Kyle reserves the right to place swimmers in different times depending on swimmer ability.

All swimmers need to wear an appropriate swim suit, goggles, a swim cap is preferred for those with longer hair.

COVID Regulations:

1. If your child is sick in ANY way, please have him/ her stay home.
2. All swimmers, parents and coaches must adhere to mask mandates in accordance with Larimer County Ordinances.
3. When swimmers enter the pool area, once they have been checked in, there will be a specific area for them to place their bags, as bags will be separated out as well.
4. Swimmers are to leave the pool area as soon as practice is over. There is break to allow entering and exit space. Swimmers need to remain outside the gate spaced from each other until they are allowed in the pool area.
5. We are going to follow the Larimer county rules regarding how many swimmers and spectators are allowed at a time.
6. The team has to supply to the county complete rosters, schedules, location of meets/practices and contact information (to include names, phone numbers and email addresses) of all team members or parents of youth who participate prior to the teams playing in any league events, including practice. Failure of parents, facilities, coaches and/or team organizers to cooperate with contact tracing may result in the league or season being suspended or canceled.

Meets:

We hope to schedule a few meets for June and July. All will be dependent on HOA and County allowance.

Swimmer, Family and Parent/Guardian's Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct defines expectations of behavior for all swim team members, families, parents, volunteers and coaches involved with the Nelson Farm Swim Team.

Please respect and abide by the following:

1. Let the swimmers swim and the coaches coach, and support both positively.
2. Bullying and aggressive behavior by team members, coaches, family members, parents and spectators will not be tolerated.
3. Team members, coaches, family members, parents and volunteers will refrain from all illegal conduct and inappropriate behavior that detracts from a positive image of the Nelson Farm Swim Team; this includes but is not limited to smoking or any drug use in, around or on the pool and tennis court grounds.
4. Team members, coaches and parents will display the utmost respect and sportsmanship towards officials, competitors and each other.
5. Criticism of the swimmers, coaches or officials will not be allowed or tolerated.
6. Damage to team property or the property of others (including other teams facilities) is prohibited and will result in removal from the Nelson Farm Swim Team immediately.
7. Team members, coaches, family members and parents are expected to leave the pool and surroundings in a neat and clean condition after practice and home meets.
8. Team members, coaches, family members and parents are expected to leave the hosting pool and surroundings in a neat and clean condition when attending away meets; trash thrown away, borrowed chairs returned, etc.
9. During meets, parents are expected to remain in the spectator area and away from the heat seating/block area unless they are working the meet in an official volunteer capacity.
10. Nelson Farm Swim Team is a volunteer community, and the success of the Nelson Farm Swim Team depends on the many adult and junior volunteers throughout the summer season. Please respect the volunteers and consider doing your part to help out by volunteering your time and talent.
11. I will do my best to make swimming fun for all children, coaches, volunteers and other families.
