SWIMMING LESSONS

According to the CDC children ages 1-4 who participate in formal swimming lessons are 88% less likely to drown. Let us help your children learn to be safe and strong swimmers! Registration for lessons is available at https://splashpoolservices.com/swimming-lessons/ May 8th.

Group Lesson Session Dates:

Session 1 June 5-June 15 Session 2 June 19- June 29 Session 3 July 10-July 20 Session 4 July 24-August 3

The second Friday of each session will only be used for make-up classes in the event of a full class cancellation.

Group lessons are participation based. Classes will only run if there are at least 3 swimmers registered for each full session. If the class you registered for does not run due to low enrollment you will have the option of applying your registration to a future session or receiving a refund.

Classes run between 9-10am each session. Specific class times are set prior to each session. You will be notified of your specific class time(s) no later than the Saturday prior to each session.

Private and semi-private lessons are also available. These are 1:1 or 2-3:1 lessons that are scheduled at your convenience with an individual instructor. Splash is no longer involved in coordinating private/semi-private lessons. You will find business cards at the pool for you to use to directly contact an instructor. You choose the time, you set the goals, you pay the instructor directly and you're on your way!

POOL ACCESS

Members are required to use the gate code to access the pool. Staff are not permitted to open the gate for people who don't know the code. The membership sign-in log is designed to identify Nelson Farm pool members to preserve the value of your membership, to promote safety and to minimize liability. Membership will be verified with a membership list provided by Colorado Association Services. Please help the lifeguards enforce this policy by signing in every time you come to the pool.

SWIMMING AND SAFETY

Drowning remains the second leading cause of accidental death for children ages 1-14 in the United States.

Although our lifeguards are provided to *assist you* with supervising your swimmers, please remember that you are ultimately responsible for the safety of your family and your guests. There is no substitute for your <u>ACTIVE SUPERVISION!</u>

Swimmers who are dependent on floatation devices to swim must be accompanied by a guardian who is in the water within one arms reach, ACTIVELY WATCHING THEM.

We strive to promote pool safety and prevent accidents around your facility through active supervision, facility safety checks, safety education, swimming lessons and enforcement of pool rules. It is only through a partnership between your family and the Splash staff that we can maintain a safe, relaxing, and enjoyable environment for your family and guests.



POOL RULES

- SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK
- On safety issues, the judgment of the guards shall supersede ALL pool rules. Complaints shall be referred to the management.
- No diving in water less than 5ft deep.
- No hypoxic training.
- The following are strictly prohibited in the pool area: Alcohol and tobacco products, Running, pushing or rough play, Excessive Noise, Playing on ropes, Profane language, Glass, Animals
- No food, gum or drinks in the water
- Hard balls and sharp toys are not permitted.

- Climbing on guard stands, fences or poles.
- Flotation devices allowed at lifeguard's discretion.
- NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY IN WADER POOL.
- The wader pool is limited to the use of non-swimmers.
- Any swimmer still wearing diapers must wear swimming diapers.
- All swimmers using the wader pool must be closely supervised (at water's edge) by a responsible individual.
- The wader pool is only open when the large pool is open.
- Flotation devices are allowed in the wader pool so long as the guards do not judge them to be a safety hazard.

POOL PARTIES AND GUESTS

GUESTS: Your family and friends are welcome to enjoy the pool with you! Each household may bring up to 5 guests per visit provided that the member remains at the pool with the guests. Babysitters will not be considered guests when accompanying a member's child.

If you plan on having more than 5 guests during one visit to the pool, please speak with the pool manager to arrange your party. You may be asked to pay for an additional lifeguard for your group.

Please remember to pick up after your group. Thank you.

Please make sure you are confident in the swimming ability of your children's guests before you send them to the pool without you.

PARTIES: The pool can be reserved for private parties Monday and Thursday nights from 6pm-8pm. A party contract and agreement will need to be signed for each private party. Please submit a party request here; <u>https://splashpoolservices.com/product/party-reservation-request-nelson-farm/.</u>

Lifeguards are required for all private events. If the number of guests at the function (this number includes swimmers and non-swimmers) is below 15 one lifeguard will be required. Additional guests will require additional lifeguards.

Management will coordinate the appropriate number of lifeguards with the hosting pool member. The charge is \$30 per lifeguard hour payable to Splash. *Please schedule your event with the pool manager at least one week in advance.*

INCLEMENT WEATHER AND LIGHTNING

If the outside temperature is below 65 degrees the pool will be closed and the lifeguard will leave the facility (no lifeguard on duty). A sign will be posted on the gate to inform members of the closure. Follow us on Facebook and Instagram to stay current on pool closures.

In the event of a thunder and/or lightning storm, the lifeguards will adhere to the



National Lightning Safety Institute policy & require all swimmers to exit the water AND pool grounds for 30 minutes after the last sound of thunder.

If the storm hinders swimming for 60 minutes, or if the bottom of the pool cannot be seen due to heavy rain, the pool will close until the storm has subsided.

For the safety of pool members and their guests the staff has the authority to close the facility during any thunder or lightning storm.
